

## JMET 2009-10 Analysis

Living up to its expectations, JMET has this year also proved it to be a Just Math and Entirely Math Exam. There were, definitely, 4 sections in the test. However, the most challenging ones were Quant and Logical reasoning. A careful selection of the questions would have made the real difference.

True to its essence, Quantitative section in JMET (Joint management entrance test) had a few sitters and their identification could have made or mar your score. Additionally, Logical Reasoning was very time consuming. Only section that could have saved your time in JMET 2009-10 was verbal Communication (except for a few vocab questions which troubled most test takers). DI was almost at the same difficulty level as that of last year's.

Additionally, the test was not completely error free. A minor printing error (though discoverable and not very distracting) was also found in the LR set. A 'Geeta' appeared from nowhere and replaced 'Rita' in the answer choices of one set!

1. Challenging Quant section!
2. Time consuming LR section
3. Ideal Overall Attempts (for at least a call from 3 IITs) = 72 - 77
4. Quant had real sitters & Verbal had a few challenging vocab questions.
