For M.C.A.:

Any Science Graduate (including B.C.A. under Science Faculty) with Mathematics at 10+2 Level.

For M.Sc. (Computer Science) :

Bachelors Degree in Computer Science.

- § **Reservation is applicable only for Maharashtra domicile candidates (SC, ST, DT/NT, OBC categories) as per Govt. of Maharashtra rule and 3% for PH.**
- § **Valid Non-creamy layer certificate is necessary for OBC, DT/NT category candidates at the time of final admissions. Caste validity certificate is necessary at the time of admission for candidates belonging to ST category.**
