Class Teacher's Fact Sheet

What is this test about?

This is an online test that has been designed to give students of class VI to X, a clear idea of what skills are expected from them and what they should do to enhance their competitive skills

TCY-NBT gives the student specific details about

- ◆ The skills he should develop today to help him succeed in top tests tomorrow.
- ◆ His standing today vis-à-vis his peers who would be his competitors tomorrow.
- ◆ How well positioned he is in various key subject areas

What would the test report look like?

The detailed report for the students would contain:

- ◆ Score Card & Certificate
- ◆ Detailed Analysis of their performance
- ◆ Subject Wise Expert Recommendations
- ◆ The Career Propensity Chart

How to prepare for this test?

This is not an Olympiad, but an assessment of a student's raw intelligence. The test takers are expected to appear for this test without any special preparation

What is the test fee?

There is no fee for taking the test. However students who wish to obtain a certificate and detailed report may deposit Rs. 150/- with the school.

What is the nature of the test?

The test would be held online in the school. It is a 2-hour test comprising 135 questions divided into five sections. The test can be taken at one go or can be taken section wise.

When and how would the students get the reports?

The reports would be available to the students through our website in downloadable form. Students can take a printout of the detailed reports, which may comprise 12 to 16 pages of detailed statistical analysis of his test performance at the national level.

How many times can a student appear for this test?

Only once in an academic session, however it is advisable to take the test again in the next academic sessions to keep a track of how you are improving your competitive position.
